Groups

Players will be placed in groups of approx. 6 bowlers. These groups will be randomly selected, before the tournament.

Each player will play all other bowlers in their group scoring points for a win or a draw.

Each game will be 12 ends.

Prior to the Tournament start date:

I will email the following to all entrants:

- A list of players in each group with the contact details for the players in the group.
- A list of all games to be played by each group

Games

Game Rules:

- Each game will be **12 ends**
- **1st two ends of a game - 1 point per end.**
- All games conclude after 12 ends with a win or a draw.

After every game – Players should update the list on the bowls notice board **and send an email** to Caroline using the email address:

- **Group number**
- **Player names**
- **Score**

Any games not completed by the deadline date for the round, will be forfeited

Forfeited Games:

The person who forfeits the game will be treated as the game loser and the opponent awarded the 3 summer tournament points for a win **BUT** there will be **NO winning game points awarded.**

Scoring (all rounds)

- **Win – 3 points**
- **Draw – 1 point**

Round 1 – must be completed between 1st May and 10th July 2026

Bowlers will be responsible for organising their own games during this period. Any games not completed will be forfeited.

Group winners:

Winners will be determined by their score and proceed to Round 2. In the event of a tie the points scored difference will be used. Points difference will be determined by calculating the (points scored – points scored by their opponent) for each game.

Round 2 – must be completed between 13th July and 22nd August 2026

Group A – Playing for the Summer tournament Winner's Trophy and Runner-Up Shield

The bowlers with the highest points in each group from Round 1 will move forward to round 2. These players will form a new group and will play all the other players in the group (as in round 1).

Group B – Playing for the Honours Shield

The bowlers who are runners-up in each group from Round 1 will move forward to round 2. These players will form a new group and will play all the other players in the group (as in round 1).

Group Tables

I will periodically publish the tables for each group to update players on their position in the group. These tables will also be placed on the bowls notice board in the pavilion.

Prizes

These will be presented during the Autumn Knockout Challenge – **Friday 4th September 2026**, to the Summer Tournament Winner, Runner-Up and Honours shield winner.
